ACCIDENT WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I acknowledge that this athletic event is an extreme test of a person’s physical and mental limits and carries with it the potential for death, serious injury and property loss. The risks include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, condition of athletes, equipment, vehicular traffic, actions of other people including, but not limited to, participants, volunteers, spectators, coaches event officials, and event monitors, and/or producers of the event, and lack of hydration. These risks are not only inherent to participants, but are also present to nonparticipating volunteers. I realize that liability may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained or controlled by them or because of their possible liability without fault. I hereby knowingly and voluntarily assume all of the risks of participating and/or volunteering in this event.

Special Event Champion – Each year, one special event champion will be named based on the performance of a certain form designated by the Federation. The special form will normally be one that was taught in the previous year's annual seminar. If no form was taught in the Previous year's seminar, another form will be designated.

A contestant can only earn one champion award. In the event of a multiple champion, awards will be determined by the tournament officials based on second and (possibly) third highest scores.

The **novice** category is for those who have studied martial arts less than 2 years; **intermediate** is 2-5 years and **advanced** is 5 or more years.

Short weapons are single-hand weapons such as double-edged straight sword (jian) and broadsword (dao); long weapons are double-hand weapons such as staff and spear.

Please prepare and bring your own weapon for Weapon Set Events.

Weapons should be traditionally weighted according to Judges' discretion.

Time range for ALL Internal Hand Forms: 4:00 – 5:00 minutes

No changes of competing events after the Check-in period are allowed.

Etiquette for salute: when the competitor's name is called, they will approach the ring and give a right fist and left open palm salute (standing vertical with both feet together) to the Head Judge only. The competitor shall not bow to any other ring official or it shall be considered a violation of protocol and will be dealt the appropriate deduction. Note that after receiving their final score, the competitor will acknowledge the score by saluting only the Head Judge.

Specifications for Costumes/Uniforms: Tops may either be school T-shirts or traditional jackets of any Chinese style and material. T-shirts shall be tucked into the pants. Pants shall be long and either gathered or open at the ankles. Uniforms should be clean and wrinkle free at the start of the competition.

No cheering from spectators.

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place of each event awards will be presented at conclusion of the Tournament. Awards for Champions will be announced at the Chuk Kai Annual Memorial Banquet.
